

YOU DON'T NEED A VISA

- (1) **Schengen area** : Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland.
- (2) **EU (European Union)** : Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, United Kingdom.
- (3) **EEA (European Economic Area)** : EU Member States + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway.
- (4) Airport transit arrangements apply when you remain in the airport's international zone waiting for a connecting flight, **in the same airport and during daytime**. If you have to catch your next flight in a different airport than the arrival one or that you have to spend the night in a hotel (airports are closed during night-time in France and you are not allowed to stay in the international zone), **short stay and no more airport transit regulations apply**.

- Holders of a valid residence permit or a valid long stay visa issued by France or any other Schengen member State⁽¹⁾
 - Holders of a valid residence permit issued by Monaco and Canada*.
